CUBG Hosts Special Webinar Series on Dealing With Problem Business Loans

(Portland, Ore. – May 22, 2009) – Business services CUSO CU Business Group, LLC will hold a special three-part webinar series on dealing with problem loans.

The series, which kicks off Thursday, May 28th aims to train credit union staff on strategies and best practices for handling delinquent and other problem loans within the MBL portfolio.

“In today’s economy it’s vital for credit unions to be prepared to act on any problems that might arise in the member business loan portfolio,” explained CUBG President/CEO Larry Middleman.

The first webinar of the series, *Basic Collections & Dealing With Problem Loans* will take place on Thursday, May 28th at 10:00 am Pacific time. This session focuses on familiarizing credit union staff with early warning signs of problem loans and an overview of the collections process.

A second webinar, *Advanced Collections, Foreclosures & Liquidations* will take place on Thursday, June 18th and covers serious collections as well as the foreclosure process on business loans. We will also discuss troubled asset management and options for liquidating collateral.

The third and final session, *Avoiding Lender Liability in the Collection Process* will be held on Thursday, July 9th. This webinar will review the critical issues surrounding lender liability and the pitfalls a credit union should avoid when it comes to managing problem business loans.

Registration for CUBG Credit Union Members is \$69 for each session or \$189 for all three. Registration for all other credit unions is \$99 each or \$279 for all three webcasts.
